

In accordance with the High Instructions of His Majesty King Mohammed VI, the Foundation Mohammed V for Solidarity launches "Operation Grand Froid".

Acting on the High Instructions of His Majesty King Mohammed VI (May God Assist Him), the Foundation Mohammed V for Solidarity has launched "Extreme Cold Operation" ("Operation Grand Froid"). This emergency humanitarian initiative aims to support populations affected by the severe cold wave currently impacting several provinces across the Kingdom.

National in scope, the operation involves the deployment of significant human and logistical resources. Conducted in close coordination with the Ministry of the Interior, it is designed to address the immediate needs of the most vulnerable communities.

The operation will cover 28 provinces affected by freezing temperatures, heavy rainfall, and snowfall. A total of 73,000 households will receive humanitarian aid consisting of essential food supplies and blankets.

A comprehensive logistical framework has been established across the targeted regions. Foundation teams—comprising administrative staff, physicians, and social assistant workers from the FAR (Royal Armed Forces) Directorate General of Social Services—are operating on the ground. Supported by local authorities, the Royal Armed Forces (FAR), and the Royal Gendarmerie, they are working to ensure aid reaches remote rural communities and high-altitude mountainous areas.
