THE MOHAMMED V FOUNDATION FOR SOLIDARITY ORGANIZES A MAJOR MEDICAL AND SURGICAL CAMPAIGN IN OUED AMLIL.

The Mohammed V Foundation for Solidarity is launching its 2026 program of local medical campaigns with its first efforts taking place during of the month of Ramadan. The medical and surgical campaign will be held in the province of Taza, from March 13 to 15, benefitting rural communities.

As part of its initiatives to bring healthcare closer to the people, this operation will be held in Oued Amlil, an area situated 28 km from Taza. It will primarily target the inhabitants of Oued Amlil as well as those of neighboring communes, notably Ghyata Al Gharbiya, Bab Boudir, and Bni Frassen, in order to facilitate their access to specialized consultations and surgeries.

The medical campaign will cover several specialties, including pediatrics, gynecology-obstetrics, cardiology, rheumatology, ophthalmology, nephrology, urology, dermatology, and dental care. Cataract surgeries will also be performed, following the patient identification effort carried out in Taza on March 6 and 7.

This campaign responds to high demand for specialized care in the region. It aims to **provide care for approximately 1,000 patients per day** and **perform nearly 130 cataract surgeries**, bringing healthcare services closer to those who need it.

All activities will be done at a single site in Oued Amlil, organized around two distinct approaches: one approach is dedicated to consultations and multidisciplinary care and another is reserved for surgical interventions, ensuring structured, secure, and efficient patient care. To implement this operation, the Foundation will deploy its mobile medical units – ophthalmology, radiology, biology, dental, and pharmacy – as well as a surgical unit provided by the Moroccan Medical Association of Solidarity (AMMS). Nearly 100 people will participate, including 33 specialist doctors (including 9 surgeons), 12 general practitioners, and 32 nurses and technicians, alongside the Foundation's teams. This campaign is conducted with the assistance of local authorities, the University Hospital Center of Fez, the Provincial Health Delegation of Taza, the Higher Institute of Nursing Professions and Health Techniques (ISPITS) of Taza, and the AMMS.

This new campaign builds on efforts previously done by the Foundation to strengthen access to specialized care. In 2025, six medical-surgical campaigns were organized in the provinces of Zagora, Tan-Tan, Berkane, Taounate, Ifrane, and Es-Smara. **467 cataract surgeries, 201 general and pediatric surgeries, and 30,022 multidisciplinary care services were offered to 13,349 people.**

In parallel, the Foundation supported the organization of two multidisciplinary caravans, implemented by partner medical associations in the provinces of Tetouan and Rabat. These resulted in **2,791 medical interventions** which benefitted **2,011 people**.

Through these actions, the Mohammed V Foundation for Solidarity continues its commitment to bringing health services closer to vulnerable populations, particularly in rural areas, and contributing to the sustainable improvement of their living conditions.
